We are looking forward to the lemonade stand again this year at Corn Days on August 9-10 at St. George's Church in Long Lake (see p. 2). It's a good chance to make the community aware of our church, plus it's fun working together at the event.

We are again working on the back-to-school program and asking the congregation to bring school supplies for the needy children at IOCP. Then on the August 17, we will fill backpacks with the supplies and deliver them to IOCP.

Also the Episcopal Group Homes' client, Jeff Galloway, is still getting his weekly ride to get food thanks to our great group of volunteers. A big thanks go out to all in our congregation who give of their time to help these worthy causes!!
