## From the Rector: "Five Moments"

### *Brothers and Sisters,*

August is upon us; soon the leaves will be changing colors and we will prepare ourselves for the colder time of the year. In the past two newsletters I have posed the question regarding taking time out to sit and be still with God.

Paul and Mary, two of our dear St. Edward's members, used to tell me, "I spent this morning with the Lord." I would often have a smile and reply, "Well, has he left?" Paul and I would share a laugh and then he would share with me his morning with the Lord. In this time he found he was able to sit and just be; he would pray offering thanksgivings and intercessions but then he would also just sit there in worship of God. Thanking God for all the blessings in his life, for his family, friends, and of course his wonderful wife Mary. In this time there were no distractions, but just Paul and the Lord. What beautiful imagery and what a beautiful time for his soul.

In June, both Paul and Mary died, and I know that they are now spending eternity with the Lord. Their faith was amazing; many times Joanie Broughton and I would go and visit. We were welcomed with bright smiles and open arms. We would sit and talk for a while and then we would share communion. At the time of the service when we would offer the prayers of the people I was blessed to be apart of their prayer. Their hearts were full of prayer and thanksgivings. We would hold hands and pray the presence of the Holy Spirit could be felt in every corner of the house. The prayer was one of desire of connection with God, a deep love of God, and a deep thanksgiving for the blessings that God had provided. This prayer was not a laundry list of there is what we need but rather began in thanksgiving, bidding prayers and then offering thanksgiving.

Paul and Mary offered to our community a wonderful gift. They would hold us in prayer; they also shared with us an example of how to sit and "spend time with the Lord." With our schedules filled to the brim with things to do, our phones ringing, texting, emailing us 24/7 we find it hard to find that quiet time to sit and be with the Lord.


### From the Rector
