## Pastoral Visit Ministry

Each month the Vestry receives a report from the Rector that details his activities since the last Vestry meeting and his plans for the coming weeks. Over time the Vestry has observed a trend -- a steadily increasing need for pastoral visits with those who are home-bound or in a care facility.

One recent and measurable example is a shift in when and where people participate in Ash Wednesday services. As seen in the table below, this year saw a slight decrease in attendance at the noon service and a jump in the number of individuals who received a pastoral visit.

In recent months, at least one full day in Fr. Jason's week has been devoted to pastoral visits, and Dcn. Morris also assists. Our Vestry recognizes the increasing amount of Fr. Jason's time and Dcn. Morris's time being devoted to pastoral care and fully supports both of them in this.

But this ministry needn't be limited to clergy. Some members already have expressed interest in re-starting our Lay Eucharistic Ministry. Having members trained and available to augment the work of our clergy not only would help at busy times but also likely would be welcomed by those receiving visits. Want to know more?
